

**Seller** prints name of purchaser(s)

- Seller prints address of purchaser(s)
- Seller enters selling price if vehicle is a gift/no money was exchanged, enter the word "gift"; if a trade, enter the word "trade".
- Seller enters the date the sale took place.
- Seller enters current
  Odometer Reading Mileage must be ente

Mileage must be entered by the seller at the time of sale to be recorded on the new title. Odometer reading is mandatory for all vehicles with a model year of 2011 or newer. Odometer reading is optional on vehicles with a model year of 2010 or older.

Seller enters the date the odometer was read.

## Completing Your **Title for Transfer**



- Seller checks the odometer box: check only one: Actual, In Excess, or Not Actual. If a box is not checked, the title transfer cannot be processed and additional paperwork will be required.
- Seller(s) signature If owners names are connected by "and", all owners must sign.
- 9 Seller(s) printed name If owners names are connected by "and", all owners must print their name.
- Purchaser(s) signature If your name is going on the title, you must sign.
- Purchaser(s) printed name Required for all buyers.
- Lienholder If there is a lienholder on the paper title, they will need to sign the lien release listed on the title or provide an original lien satisfaction.
- The original title, certificate of origin, or other legal proof of ownership must be completed in full prior to applying for transfer.
- All applicants must be present with valid identification or provide a valid power of attorney.
- Information on the title cannot be missing, altered, or written over. When mistakes are made, a signed affidavit explaining the error(s) are required.
- To obtain a license plate, proof of current Florida insurance must be provided. Excludes motorcycles and trailers.
